Report on Ban on the use of plastics and Landscaping with trees and plants

- 1. Ban on the use of plastics: The institution is located in Aizawl which is under the jurisdiction of Aizawl Municipal Corporation (AMC). AMC has banned the use of single use plastics within Aizawl for reduction non-biodegradable waste. Following this, Eco club, GZRSC has taken initiatives to make a plastic free campus and has collaborated with AMC to spread awareness among students. Class to class campaign and plastic free drive has been undertaken where students, office staff and faculty actively participated.
- 2. Landscaping with trees and plants: Landscaping using trees have been undertaken under the initiative of Eco Club and NSS unit GZRSC. Tree saplings received from Forest dept. were planted to mark boundaries and to stabilize areas prone to landslides. Existing trees are also carefully managed and building site plans are designed to cause minimal damage. Crop plantation is also undertaken in vacant sites providing fresh supply of vegetable to hostellers.



The function came to an end with a vote of thanks from the Chairman followed by an official photo session. The event was attended by 68 students along with 7 teachers of the Club.












Pic 1: Mrs Lalrosangpuii, Assistant Professor delivering a speech








