INNOVATION CLUB

2015-2016

In pursuance of the Innovation Club Mizoram University letter, Innovation Club, Govt Zirtiri Residential Science College was formed on September, 2015. The following faculties are appointed as members:

The club had its first meeting on the 16th September 2015. The meeting decided that an executive committee comprising students from different streams need to be formed. As such, the Executive Committee comprising 16 members i.e. 12 students from Science, Home Science, Computer Science and 4 faculties.

Activities:

1. Conducted membership drive and awareness programme on January, 2016. 287 students are enrolled as club members.
2. On 22nd and 23rd Feb, 2016, Mr Lalhrulaitluanga, the chairman accompanied 11 students to participate in the 'Celebration of Creativity & Innovation ' at the Mizoram University campus. In this event, our ex-student Mr Krista Roluahpuia (2006-2009) currently a research scholar in IIT, Mumbai was invited to give a motivational talk on his present research topic, his experience as a student and his ideas and philosophy about education, research and development.
4. Organized an initiative called 'Something for My College'. The initiative aims to encourage and motivate students and faculties to contribute any items for enhancing the quality of the college. The main idea is to give back something to the college
