## **Short Report:**

The Programme started with a introduction of organizing members and college faculty from the host Mrs. Lalrinsangi Nghinglova who also gave the welcome speech in the absence of the Principal who had fallen sick. The first session opened with presentation fro Dr. Caleb Harris on the topic "Is the cancer rates higher in North East India because of Bad genetics? He gave an overview on the incidence of cancer in the North East states and identified some of the common cause of cancer in the region. He also posed the question whether cancer is genetic or sporadic. He also suggested some cancer preventive measures.

In the second and third sessions Dr. Balajied Nongrum gave powerful presentations on two topics "The intersection of Science and faith" in which he talks about how Science and faith are not foes but friends. In his talk on "The Matrix of human sexuality" he delved into the complexity of human sexuality. Contemporary issues such as LGBTQ etc were also discussed. This session was followed by a session on the role of religion (Christianity in particular) in the contemporary society which was presented by Lalrinzuala Nghaka. Topics ranging from existence of God, our purpose in life and what happens after death were discussed. The two sessions were followed by Q&A session. In between all the sessions a well known a singer Maruati gave an astounding performance. The resource persons were gifted mementoes from the college. The sessions ended with a vote of thanks from Dr. Lalzahawmi Chenkual, Chairman, Research & Development Cell, GZRSC.
