(b) Updating of SBI Account: Resolved that the college account at State Bank of India, Aizawl Main Branch should be updated for the purpose of receiving admission fees in the online mode. The name in which the account is opened may also be changed from Zirtiri Women's College to Principal, Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College. The Saving Bank account no is 10763533129.

As per the decision of the admission Committee in its meeting on 27th Feb. 2020, direct admission will be given to students who attain 55% in Theory (Science) alone. Admission notice will be given as soon as results of Class XII examinations are declared. Admission can be done in online and off-line mode. Admission will be open for one week as soon results are declared. Notice will be given through television and local newspaper. Those qualified for direct admission will have to pay admission fee within 2 days of their selection in the online or offline mode. Online payment will be made to the college through SBI account No. 10763533129.

Those who do not qualify for direct admission will be considered by the admission committee. Selected candidates will be declared within one week after closing of admission by admission committee after screening. Admission to BCA and Home Science will be given on first come first serve basis.

Fee structure was tabled and accepted with minor modifications. A sum of Rs. 100 has been added for payment by final year students for alumni registration.

Soft copy of Prospectus after modification will be submitted by those given charge to Webmaster by 12th July, 2020. Prospectus will be uploaded on the college website for free download.

Online Advertisement for the college admission will be taken by the ICT committee. They will be assisted by Dr. Ricky Lalhmangaihzuala and Dr. C. Zoramthara.

Monitoring of online admission will be done by the Webmaster Sir. H. Thangkhanhau and Lalthatluanga.

3. Appointment of our college as NEET exam Center.

In response to the Invitation by the National Testing Agency to register ourselves as centres for NEET (UG) 2020 exam, the meeting has resolved that the college will respond in the affirmative and offer its campus as NEET exam center.

4. Opening of Boys' Hostel for students facing Problem due to Lockdown: The committee has resolved that the boy's hostel at Durtlang shall be made available for our students who have faced accommodation problem. Such students will be identified through the mentoring system. Around 45 seats are available for Boys.

Light and sound committee will look into the electricity connection issues.

Those students who want to join the hostel will do the cleaning work.
