

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between

Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College, Aizawl, Mizoram.

&

Mizoram State Legal Services Authority For The Establishment of Legal Aid Clinic.

The purpose of this MoU is to establish Legal aid clinic in Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College under the guidance of Mizoram State Legal Services Authority with a view to promote legal literacy and empowerment among the students. The core purpose of this clinic is to create legal awareness among students

and local community in the college vicinity.

CLAUSE 1 Scope of the MoU

Through this memorandum, both Parties affirm the value of collaboration and agree to promote the following activities:

- 1.1 Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College shall provide required facilities like rooms and other amenities within the campus for the establishment of the Legal Clinic.
- 1.2 Mizoram State Legal Services Authority shall provide Advocate (s) who will direct and coordinate the activities of the Legal Aid Clinic which includes creation of legal awareness, legal counseling and offering of services such as making of affidavit etc at a minimal rate.
- 1.3 The Legal Aid clinic shall play a decisive role in making the students aware about their legal rights and duties.
- 1.4 The Legal aid clinic shall open twice a week in the college campus.
- 1.5 Other activities as mutually agreed.
- 1.6 This MoU places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either Party.

CLAUSE 2 Relationship between the parties:

2.1 It is expressly agreed that the Parties acting under this MoU are independent contractors and the relationship under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. The Legal Clinic is set up in the college campus solely for academic purpose. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or to create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to piedge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 3 Validity:

- 3.1 This Agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by both Parties. It shall remain valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be modified by written mutual consent of both Parties.
- 3.2 This Agreement may be terminated by either Party with advance written notice of at least thirty (30) days.
- 3.3 The MoU may be extended by mutual consent of the two Parties after the twoyears period, and it must be renewed in writing.

This Memorandum of Understanding completed in English is hereby signed in two (2) copies with one (1) copy remaining in the possession of each Party.
