There were two resource persons:

- 1. Mr. Lalthanpuia, Scientist'B': His topic was "Overview of Climate Change". He started by defining Climate change, its effects over a definite period of time. He explained the many cases of the effects of warming of the earth that had taken place with clear examples, and how the climate change and global warming could adversely affect all the living beings in all the parts of the world. He concluded by saying what could be done by all the individual to slow down global warming.
- 2. Dr. Lalchhandami Tochhawng, Scientific Officer: Her topic was "Utilization of Local Bioresources: Prospects and Potentials". She started by explaining the 'Ecological Hotspots' of different regions of the earth, how our state Mizoram was included under one of the ecological hotspots. The vast natural resources remain quite unexplored, even though it has many important flora and fauna, many medicinal plants with a potential marketable value. The studies of rich biodiversity of Mizoram could be an interesting research topic for students as well as faculty. The bioproducts that we have now can also be made more profitable by simple value-added marketing skills. She invited the participants/students to do


research more and more on the studies of the flora and fauna of Mizoram, to explore and document what we have in the state.
