It is learnt that some of these students were on the verge of dropping out due to the financial crisis and the audit team appreciates the timely action of the institute. Personality development programme during 25/5/2016-1/7/2016.
- 1 faculty presented a paper at an international conference and 5 faculties presented papers at National conferences.
- Financial assistance amounting to Rs 12650 was given to economically deprived students from the student endowment fund which has been generated from the monthly collection of the teaching Faculty.
- Choice Based Credit System has been introduced by the university in its affiliating colleges and a sensitization program for teachers on the system was organized on 29/1/2016.
- The college has a minor research Project worth Rs 4 lakhs under UGC NERO and a Major project worth Rs 10 lakhs under PIG (DST-FIST,Chemistry)
- The college offers CCC as an add-on course for its final year students.110 students enrolled for the program and successfully completed the course.
- The college also offered a Short Term Course on Personality Development for its Final year students. 82 students successfully participated in the program.
- SPV Power Plant, Lab equipments, furniture, chemicals and other immediate requirements were purchased.
- The College received grants under model Degree College by RUSA.With the first installment for model colleges received, construction of laboratory building was started. The total cost for the project is Rs 4 Crore.
- On-going Construction of Library Building with fund from SPA amounting to Rs 1.44 crore.

OBSERVATION: The internal Academic- Administrative audit has been initiated by the institute in pursuance of the IQAC meeting dated 17.2.2017. The audit for 2015-16 has been done retrospectively as the decision to initiate the internal audit was taken in the subsequent period and the 2015-16 period is to be included in the next cycle of accreditation.The proforma


for Academic Audit issued by the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education, Govt of Mizoram was a little complicated and until it is revised, the institute has devised its own mechanism for internal Academic-Administrative Audit.

The Audit report has been made from documents received from concerned departments and submitted to the IQAC with the following recommendations for further improvement.



- More research projects be taken up


