


Student Endowment Fund

The faculty of Government Zirtiri Residential Science College has been providing financial assistance to students in need of it since 2016. Fund has been derived from the student endowment fund, which is an accrual of monthly collection from the faculty members. Needy students are identified through the mentoring system and the Student Support committee has been assigned to look after collection and distribution of fund. Students identified by mentors are interviewed by the committee to ensure the authenticity and to provide necessary counseling so that funds received by them are utilized properly.



For the 2022-23 (odd) semester a total of 8 students were given financial aid at the rate of Rs 3500 per student.

An interview was conducted by the student support committee where a good number of students turned up.



14 students were shortlisted for the work. Cleaning areas were identified in Block 2,3,& 4 In Durtlang Campus and also in the campus at Ramthar. 1/3 of the total number of students worked in rotation for a month for each group on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Their wage is given to them on the last

day of the month by the treasurer of the student support committee. In addition to their normal routine interested students in the list are given employment on non-working days to provide them with much required funds.
