Brief summary of the topic:

The topic was related to gender equality is a fundamental right made to ensure the protection and promotion of gender rights. The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) that replaces the Indian Penal Code and addresses such as sexual harassment, domestic

violence, stalking, acid attacks, and trafficking, with stricter punishment for offences against women and children and Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) replaces the Code of Criminal Procedure that promotes victim-centric procedures, including witness protection, speedy trials, and sensitive handling of cases involving women and children. Other Important Laws are

- i) Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 – Provides protection and legal support to victims of domestic abuse.
- ii) Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act, 2013 – Prevents and addresses workplace harassment.
- iii) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 – Prohibits giving or taking dowry
- iv) POCSO Act, 2012 – Protects children from sexual abuse and exploitation.
