Brief summary of the activity:

The Old Age Home, run by the Salvation Army Church, is situated in a congenial location and functions under the supervision of the Superintendent. The objective of the visit was to facilitate meaningful interaction between the students and the elderly inmates as part of their practical training.

After a warm formal greeting and introduction, each student conducted individual interactions with the inmates. Gifts, contributed by both students and teachers, were presented to the elderly residents as well as to the staff of the Home.

After spending two hours at the Home, the group proceeded to Thenzawl to visit the handloom centre. The students were shown the complete handloom setup, including the yarn, design patterns, and the process of weaving. They were also introduced to popular designs and the marketing aspects of handloom products.

The handloom centre was the final site of the visit. On the way back, a short halt was made at a park to allow the students to rest and refresh. The group then resumed the journey and departed for Aizawl at 3:30 PM.

The students found the visit both interesting and informative. It was an eventful experience that significantly enriched their knowledge.
