As part of our academic curriculum, our class 6th semester of Computer science visited the Cyber Crime Police Station, Treasury Square, Aizawl on 4th March, 2025. The main purpose of this visit was to gain practical knowledge and awareness about cybercrimes and the functioning of the cybercrime unit.

We were warmly welcomed by the cybercrime officials. The session began with an informative briefing about the various types of cybercrimes such as online fraud, misuse of fake accounts, identity theft, cyberbullying, hacking, phishing, vishing and various scamming activities involving account buying and selling. Additionally, the officers explained the procedure for filing cyber complaints and gave us insights into the tools and technologies they use to investigate cases, some of their commonly used being ICJS to check criminal records and CEIR (Central Equipment Identity Register), a database of mobile device identifiers, such as IMEI numbers.

The students and faculty coordinator even raised some questions which were kindly and precisely answered by the officers. After the session, we were left with a complete understanding of various cyber laws and IT Act, how complaints are commonly registered and processed, common cyber-threats and safety measures and opened our eyes to various cyber crimes around us.

In addition, we performed some minor activity by going to a website to file a First Information Report (FIR) on cyber crimes by filling up our various information followed by filling up the nature of the cyber crimes and giving details about the incidents.

In conclusion, the visit was highly educational and beneficial as they provided us with valuable insights and knowledge about the importance of cybersecurity. We thank our faculty and the cybercrime police officials for giving us this opportunity.
