II. Activity Summary:

The programme was chaired by Dr Larinmawia, Associate Professor, Department of Zoology. The chairman provided an introduction outlining competitive exams in India and Mizoram.

The chairman then invited the resource person RK Hnuna to deliver a talk on competitive exams, with a focus on the Staff Selection Commission (SSC). He began by discussing the necessity of a life action plan. He then outlined the nature of SSC jobs including their salaries and postings. He proceeded to explain the exams with the required classifications, which are 10th, 12th and graduate level. He also detailed the syllabus and the nature of the exams, which predominantly consist of multiple-choice questions.

He then addressed the reasons why SSC is particularly advantageous for students from Mizoram, as it is a central government job with substantial salaries and benefits. He noted the relatively low number of Mizo people employed in the SSC compared to other states in North East India. This could present challenges for state government employees including members of parliament from Mizoram when the need to pass through central government arises for state government files.

Overall, the seminar was a great success, providing the second-semester students with a valuable approach to life and a foundation for success in competitive exams.
