II. Activity Summary:

The programme was chaired by Mrs. S Thangrimawi, Head of Department, Department of Zoology. The chairman provided a brief introduction outlining the importance and necessity of wetland knowledge.

The chairman then invited the resource person Dr. Lalzahawmi Chenkual to give a talk on the core components and types of wetlands, and their significance as a self-sustaining environment. She subsequently discussed the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands and highlighted that Palak Dil is the only Ramsar site in Mizoram. She also mentioned other wetlands in the state such as Tamdil Lake. The talk continued with a discussion on the importance of wetland conservation, noting that they are being destroyed by government and private development projects. She also emphasised the dangers of introducing alien species to natural ecosystems. The talk concluded with a call for the preservation of Mizoram's wetlands.
